Prior approval for COMM 487 is required. Examples of projects suitable for COMM 487: (students must complete only ONE experience)

Option 1: Co-curricular activities. Students must attend fifteen co-curricular events (lectures, film showings, symposia, colloquia, etc.) on campus that speak to the thematic focus of the certificate: diversity, inclusion, power and privilege, intersections of race, class, gender, sexuality, social justice and so forth. Students are responsible for filling out the "Co-Curricular Attendance Form" for each event. Students will enroll in zero-one hour of COMM 487.

<u>Option 2:</u> Internship. Students must complete a 12 week internship with an organization that speaks to the thematic focus of the certificate. Students will enroll in zero-one hour of COMM 487.

Option 3: Research Project: Students will complete a capstone research project on a communication and diversity topic of their choice. Students must find a willing faculty member to guide them through the research process. The student and faculty member must complete the "CDSJ Research Form" and submit to CDSJ capstone chair. Taking three credits of 491 is not required, but can be taken to help facilitate the research process. Students are expected to present their final research project at an appropriate venue on or off campus (possibilities include the Communicating Diversity Conference and Student Research Week). The research project can incorporate service learning. Students will enroll in zero-one hour of COMM 487.
