<b>Foreign Language:</b> Complete <b><u>ONE</u></b> of the following: A) Two years of the same foreign language in High School B) A two-semester sequence of the same foreign language for university credit	
<b>University Writing Requirement:</b> Students <b>must</b> complete 6 credit hours of approved [UWRT] coursework.	
<b>OPTIONAL Certificate:</b> An undergraduate certificate in the Department of Communication and Journalism is <b>OPTIONAL</b> to add to this degree. It <b><u>CANNOT</u></b> be used in place of the <b>REQUIRED SCIENCE MINOR</b> . Certificates must be declared by no later than 75 hours. <b><u>If the certificate is not declared by 75 hours, you FORFEIT the option to earn a certificate.</u></b>
