### Guidelines for Submission:

- To submit your paper, email it, as a .docx file and a .pdf file, to:

- Title the subject heading of the email: "Aletheia Submission - [The Name of Your Paper]."
- Papers should be be **2000-7000 words** in length (submissions slightly above or below this limit are welcome) in 12-point font Times New Roman and double-spaced.
- Include an approximately 150-250-word abstract
- Follow the Chicago Manual of Style Notes and Bibliography style for citations (although other formatting, such as MLA or APA, will be allowed during the review for acceptance process).
- You must be an undergraduate at the time of submission.
- Only one submission per author.
- Please include: Your name, preferred email, name of paper, and name of your institution in your email with your submission.
- Format your paper for blind review process (i.e. remove your name or any other identifying information in your paper before submitting).
