Notes:

* **English Proficiency:** You must pass ENGL 104 with a grade of “C” or better to satisfy the state mandated English proficiency requirement.

****Foreign Language:** Students are not required to take Greek or Latin, but are still required to complete 14 hours of a foreign language (four-course sequence in Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Greek, Italian, Japanese, Latin, Russian, or Spanish) as part of the College of Liberal Arts B.A. curriculum.

Writing Intensive (W) Requirement: All students must take 2 courses in their major that are designated as fulfilling the writing intensive requirement (W).

Residency requirements: You must complete at least 36 hours of upper level (300/400) course work at A&M. Twelve of the 36 hours must be upper level courses in the major field of study.

Computing hours for the CLAS degree: You **may not** use the same course to satisfy two different degree requirements for the CLAS major; however, some courses may be “doubled” to satisfy a double major, double degree or a minor requirement.

All students must take 2 courses that are designated as fulfilling an International and Cultural Diversity requirement (ICD). These courses can be courses in the major or any other part of the degree plan.

AP, IB, CLEP, and SAT II Credit. Students may now claim credits from these tests through their HOWDY portal. Students should consult their advisor before claiming credits.
