RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT: You must complete at least 36 hours of upper level (300/400) coursework at A&M. A maximum of 18 hours of upper level coursework can come from study abroad. At least 12 of the 36 hours must be upper level courses in the major field of study.

Computing hours for the MODL degree: You may **not** use the same course to satisfy two different degree requirements for the MODL major; however, some courses may be “doubled” to satisfy a double major, double degree or a second minor requirement.

All MODL majors must select a minor field of study. The minor will consist of a minimum of 15 hours of coursework, as defined by the minor department. No more than 9 credit hours may be at the 100-299 level. Interdisciplinary minors such as women’s and gender studies, classical studies, religious studies, and business have specific requirements; students should consult undergraduate advisors in these areas of study. A second major may substitute for the minor.
